



# PULMAN PARK MOTORCAMP RULES & REGULATIONS

**Freedom Camping is strictly prohibited**

***A Bruce Pulman Park Motorhome Sticker must be displayed on your dashboard at all times***

## **Rules & Regulations**

- These **Rules and Regulations** apply to all persons occupying a Motorhome Park site at the Bruce Pulman Park.
- All behaviour must comply with reasonable standards of decency and order as determined by the Manager of Bruce Pulman Park. Where a person's behaviour does not comply with reasonable standards of decency and order, Bruce Pulman Park may (and without notice, warning or refund) order that person to cease such behaviour and order such person to leave the Park.
- All those using the Motorhome Park must register and pay at the Gymsport & Recreation Centre or Pulman Arena Reception on arrival. The Park requires any person that is staying on the Park to acknowledge and sign these Rules & Regulations so they are bound by them.
- Speed limit around Park is 20kph
- Motorhomes must park within the designated site park and must not obstruct common roadways.
- Pets are not permitted within the Park grounds
- No firearms may be brought into the Park
- All **rubbish** must be taken with you on your departure from the Park
- Open fires and fireworks are prohibited.
- Any person(s) who cause damage to Park property or communal property must reimburse the Park for rectification of such damage.
- Children are the responsibility of parents/caregivers and are to be controlled and supervised as such at all times. Parents/caregivers are responsible for the actions of their children.
- All motorhomes must display a current electrical WOF at all times and comply with LPG standard (NZS 5428:1988) and all applicable lawful requirements statutory, local authority or otherwise. They must have their own waste water system or container. Chemical or cassette toilets must be emptied in the dump station.
- Motor campers must secure their own sites. A functional smoke alarm and first extinguisher of appropriate capacity must be installed.
- All persons within the Park must follow the directions of the Manager generally and further must comply with all relevant laws, regulations and by-laws at all times relating to health and safety.
- Gates open daily 7am – 9pm, Reception open weekdays 8am – 5pm
